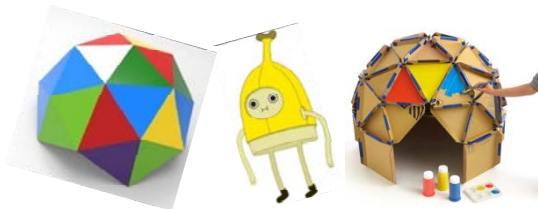
All San Diego County Middle and High School students to

Each team of approximately 6 students will construct their own large geodesic dome out of rolled up newspapers (all materials and instruction will be provided). And if that isn't challenging enough, teams are encouraged to experiment with the finished product in unique ways:



- Clad the exterior in colored papers or the newspaper comics
- Determine how much weight the structure can support
- Toss a sheet over it and see if it can become a club house . . . or
- Let your teams identify and decorate it as you wish!

The idea behind this **DomeSweetDome** building project is to get a better understanding about the built environment, lightweight structures, temporary shelter, the strength of triangles, and teamwork . . . while enjoying Civita Park (aka Mission Valley's "Central Park").

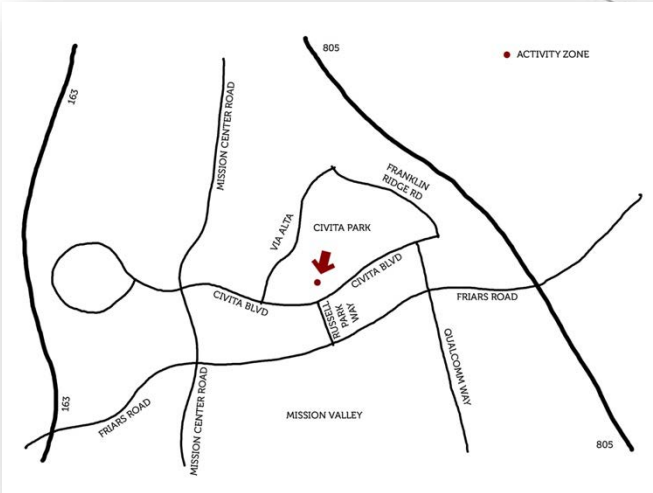
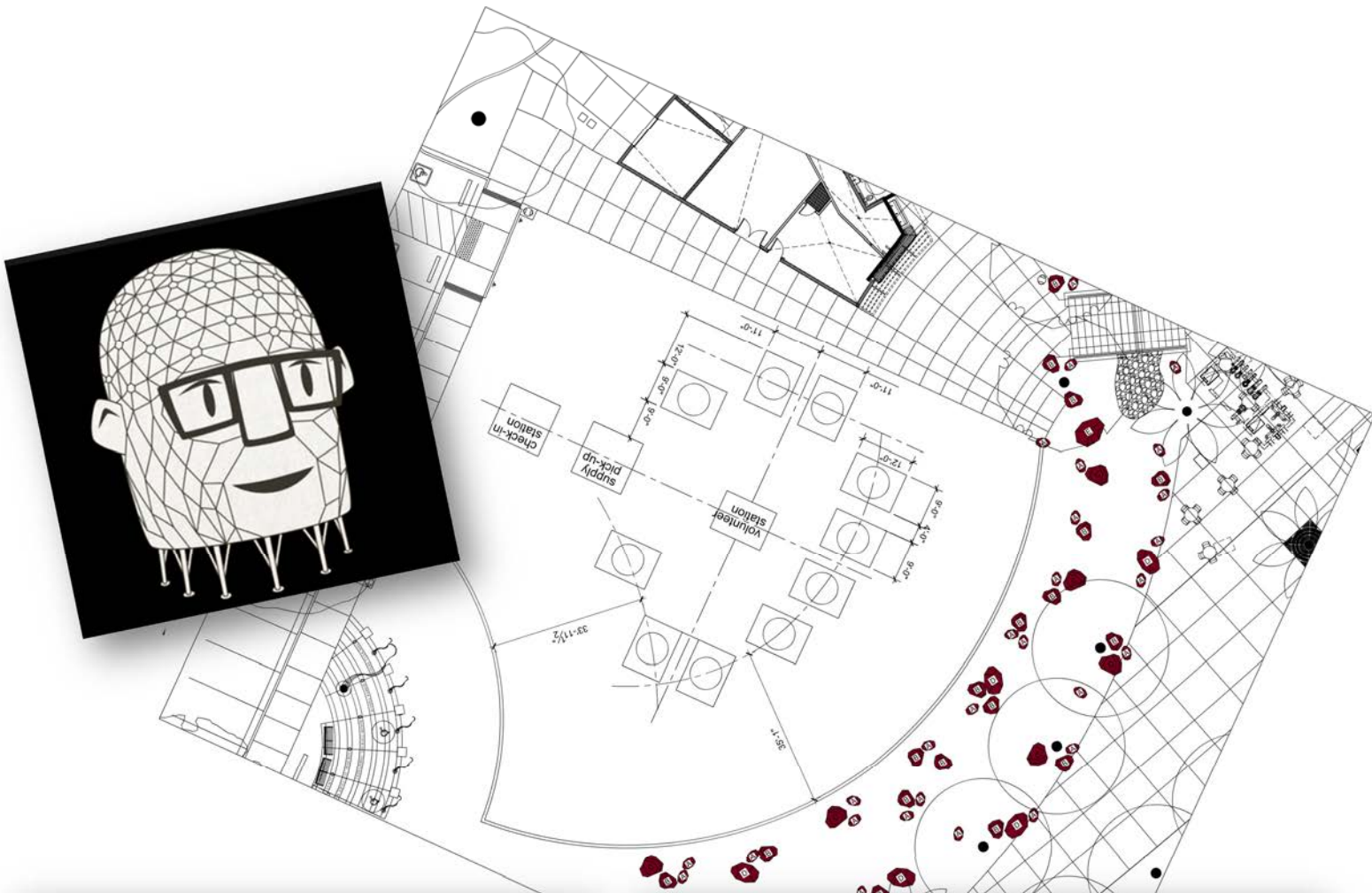
